APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of February 3, 2016 were approved as presented.

Larry Sylver discussed the Concert schedule. Two bands could not perform on the days the Recreation Committee assigned them. Larry is in the process of getting information for a replacement for one of the spots. Lori sent over the open date to the band Red Light Roxy to see if they can play on the alternate day. Lori also sent the band information over to the Law Department for legislation to be drawn up for the March 2, 2016 Council meeting.

Mayor Cegelka questioned if all Committee meetings are set for March. There is a Recreation Meeting scheduled for 7:00 p.m. on March 2, 2016. The Public Hearing will be held March 2, 2016 to discuss the Building and Zoning Code updates. Gurvis asked if residents can obtain copies of the updates before the Public Hearing. The updates were too large to post on the website; therefore they may come into Village Hall to pick up a hard Copy. Mark Marong stated Planning Commission is going to be given 30 days to look over the updates therefore; after the Public Hearing the updates will be put on second reading. At the April 6, 2016 Council meeting it will come before Council for approval.

Barb DiBacco scheduled a tentative Safety Meeting for April 6, 2016. This date and time needs to be confirmed with Chief Megyesi first.

Jeff Adie questioned if there needs to be a Personnel Meeting scheduled in the near future. Mayor Cegelka responded a meeting will need to be scheduled for May.

Larry Sylver commented that the train study information was not in the newsletter. Mayor Cegelka stated Mike Henry will be submitting the results to the Ohio Rail Road Commission and write something up to

send out to residents. Larry also asked about the status of the street light on the corner of Maplewood and Pettibone. Mayor Cegelka stated he will check with Mike Henry on the status of this.

Gurvis Smith suggested a discussion for the Smoke testing done on Tinkers Valley take place at the next Work Session. Mayor Cegelka reported that a meeting was held with the homeowners and is now waiting for more information and input from them.

Mayor Cegelka reminded Council of the site-visit tomorrow and Cleveland Steel Container at 5:30 p.m.

There being no further business to come before Council, motion by Gurvis Smith, seconded by Jeff Adie to adjourn the meeting. Vote on the motion to adjourn was all yeas and no nays.
