I hope that your New Year is going well.

Monday is the scheduled day for Glenwillow's pick up of trash and recyclables. Your trash and recyclable items need to be out before 7 AM. Recycled items must be placed in the blue recyclable container. If you put items out on Sunday, do so after 5 PM. When the following holidays fall on a Monday, your pick-up date will be the next day, Tuesday. The holidays are: Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Christmas Day, and New Year's Day.

This spring/summer, the Village will be constructing the Streetscape for the south side of Pettibone Road from Tinkers Creek Bridge east to the Railroad Station. The work involved will consist of landscaping, new traffic signalization at the intersection of Pettibone Road and Austin Powder Drive, street lighting, concrete aprons, and a sidewalk crossing of the railroad tracks.

The Village received a grant of \$150,000 from the Cuyahoga County Community Development Block Grant Program and the Village's portion of the total cost being approximately \$35,000. Hopefully, this construction will not require any closing of the roads or detours.

Attached is a copy of the Ward Map for your use. Your Council person's name and phone numbers are listed as well.

I will keep you informed of any further developments.

FREE ELECTRONIC FILING & PAYMENT OPTIONS FOR MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX

BUSINESSES AND RESIDENTS CAN FILE TAXES AND MAKE PAYMENTS ON-LINE THROUGH

The Regional Income Tax Agency (R.I.T.A.) at www.ritaohio.com.

Employers filing withholding returns are provided two choices:

- Fill in a simple withholding form, or
- Attach a payroll file

A secured ACH payment (electronic debit of a checking account) completes the filing.

Individual taxpayers are provided the following features:

- A simple step-by-step calculation of taxes or refunds
- Ability to file even if you moved in 2006
- Electronic transfer of refunds into checking or savings accounts
- Pay by credit card or ACH (electronic debit of checking or savings accounts)
- Delay payment of taxes – file as early as you like and set up an ACH payment anytime before April 15th

Here's what you'll need to E-FILE:


- Social Security numbers for yourself and your spouse.
- W2 forms from all employers.
- 1099 forms and Federal Schedules C, E, & F.
- Date of move for residents that moved in 2006.
- Bank Routing and Account numbers – for a fast refund or to pay electronically


